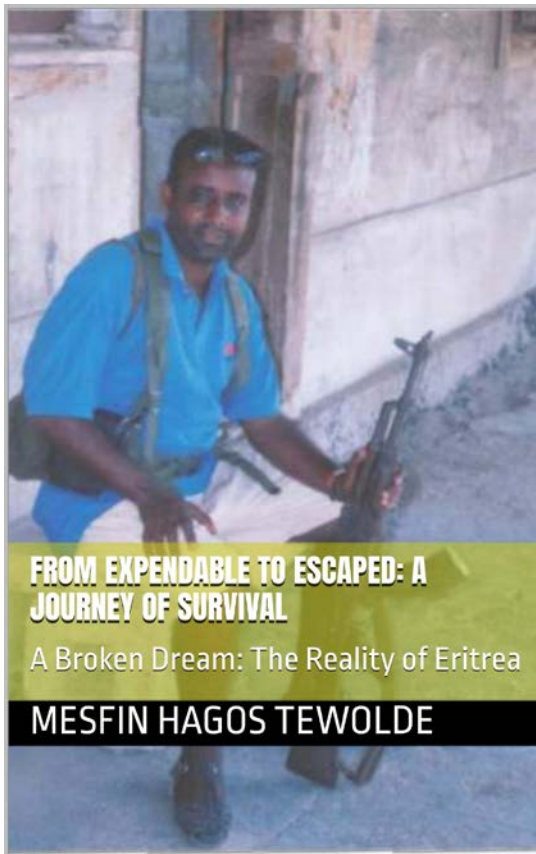
You are not a victim. You are a creator. You are not separate from God. You are one with the Source. And when you claim your true name — I AM THAT I AM — you step into your divine inheritance.

Let us live by truth, guided by the eternal light within. Let us free ourselves from illusion, and in doing so, help awaken a new world.

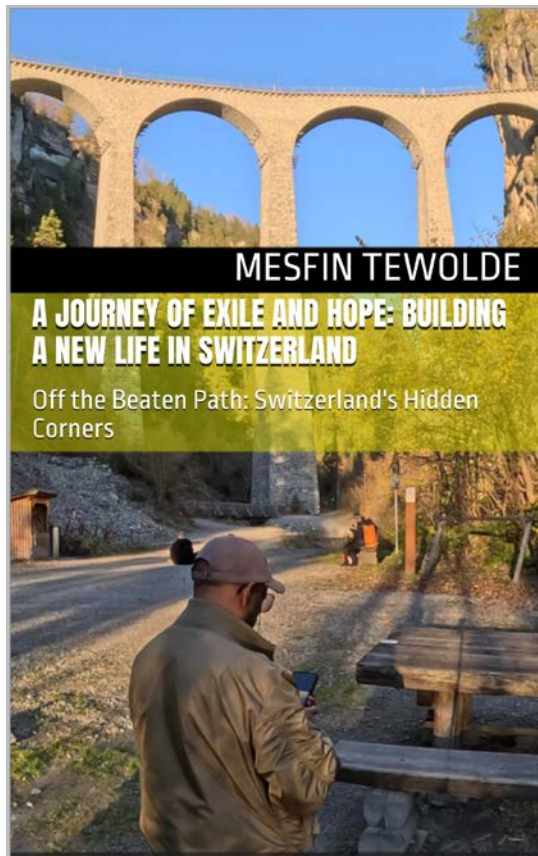
